- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 9-5-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 9-5-7. There shall be three (3) chancellors for the First
- 8 Chancery Court District. For purposes of appointment and
- 9 <u>election</u>, the three (3) chancellors shall be separate and distinct
- 10 and denominated for purposes of appointment and election only as
- 11 <u>"Place One," "Place Two" and "Place Three."</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 13 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 14 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 15 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 16 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 17 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 18 extended.
- 19 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 21 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
