- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 19-25-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 7
- 19-25-31. Each judge of a circuit, chancery or county court, 8
- or a court of eminent domain may, in the judge's discretion, by 9
- 10 order entered on the minutes of the court, allow the sheriff
- riding bailiffs to serve in the respective court of such judge, 11
- not to exceed four (4) bailiffs. Any such person so employed 12
- 13 shall be paid by the county on allowances of the court on issuance
- of a warrant therefor in the amount of Seventy-five Dollars 14
- 15 (\$75.00) for each day, or part thereof, for which he serves as
- bailiff when the court is in session. No full-time deputy sheriff 16
- 17 shall be paid as a riding bailiff of any court. County court
- judges shall be limited to one (1) bailiff per each court day. 18
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19
- 20 and after October 1, 2000.
