- AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION

 63-7-40 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972 TO PROHIBIT VEHICLES FROM BEING
- 2 63-7-40, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT VEHICLES FROM BEING 3 EQUIPPED WITH OR VEHICLE OPERATORS FROM USING LAMPS OR LIGHTING
- 4 DEVICES DESIGNED TO BE USED OR USED TO SHINE IN, ON OR UPON
- 5 ANOTHER PASSING VEHICLE OR ITS PASSENGERS; TO PRESCRIBE A PENALTY
