HOUSE BILL NO. 1285

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-25-38, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR RETIRED PHYSICIANS SERVING 1 2 3 THE MISSISSIPPI LEGISLATURE AS "DOCTOR OF THE DAY"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 73-25-38, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 73-25-38. (1) Any licensed physician or certified nurse 8 practitioner who voluntarily provides needed medical or health 9 10 services to any person without the expectation of payment due to the inability of such person to pay for said services shall be 11 immune from liability for any civil action arising out of the 12 provision of such medical or health services provided in good 13 faith on a charitable basis. This section shall not extend 14 15 immunity to acts of willful or gross negligence. Except in cases of rendering emergency care wherein the provisions of Section 16 17 73-25-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, apply, immunity under this section shall be extended only if the physician or certified nurse 18 19 practitioner and patient execute a written waiver in advance of 20 the rendering of such medical services specifying that such services are provided without the expectation of payment and that 21 22 the licensed physician or certified nurse practitioner shall be 23 immune as provided herein.

- 30 unless the act or omission was the result of the physician's gross
- 31 negligence or wilful misconduct. In order for the immunity under
- 32 this subsection to apply, there must be a written or oral
- 33 agreement for the physician to provide a voluntary noncompensated
- 34 medical service before the rendering of the service by the

- 36 (3) Any physician who is retired from active practice, and
- 37 who has been previously issued an unrestricted license to practice
