HOUSE BILL NO. 1382

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY
2 28 AND U.S. HIGHWAY 61 IN JEFFERSON COUNTY AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND
3 TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
4 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED
5 PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
8 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
9 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
10 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.

11 (2) The following highways are designated as a state highway
12 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
13 Transportation Commission for maintenance; and such highways,
14 together with the highways designated in Sections 65-3-3 and
15 65-3-5 and all other laws adding links to the designated state
16 highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of
17 Mississippi:

18 Central District - Jefferson County:

19 Those portions of Mississippi Highway 28 and U.S.
20 Highway 61 in Jefferson County that were maintained
21 prior to July 1, 2000, by the City of Fayette and
22 Jefferson County.

23 (3) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
24 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
25 highways designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
26 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
27 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3.

28 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
29 and after July 1, 2000.
