## HOUSE BILL NO. 1447

1	AN ACT TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE
2	KNOWN AS THE MISSISSIPPI MUNICIPALITIES COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY
3	DEVELOPMENT GRANT FUND; TO PRESCRIBE THE USE OF THE FUND; TO
4	PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FUND; AND FOR RELATED

5 PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) There is created a special fund in the State
- 8 Treasury to be known as the "Mississippi Municipalities
- 9 Comprehensive Community Development Grant Fund." The Department
- 10 of Economic and Community Development shall administer the fund.
- 11 Any municipality with a population of twenty-five thousand
- 12 (25,000) or less, according to the most recent federal decennial
- 13 census, is eligible to receive grants from the fund and may apply
- 14 to the Department of Economic and Community Development. Grants
- 15 shall not exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) per
- 16 application and no municipality shall be awarded more than One
- 17 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for any fiscal year. Each
- 18 municipality awarded grant funds shall be required to match
- 19 twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount awarded.
- 20 (2) The fund shall consist of monies appropriated by the
- 21 Legislature and any grants or gifts from the federal government or
- 22 any other legal source, whether public or private. Any monies
- 23 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse
- 24 into the General Fund but shall remain in the fund and any
- 25 interest accruing to the fund shall remain in the fund.
- 26 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2000.
