## HOUSE BILL NO. 1515

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE GOVERNOR TO DESIGNATE A PERSON IN HIS OFFICE TO BE A CHILDREN'S SERVICES COORDINATOR; TO PROVIDE THAT THE CHILDREN'S SERVICE COORDINATOR WILL HAVE THE DUTY OF RECEIVING 3 INQUIRIES FROM THE PUBLIC RELATED TO CHILDREN'S SERVICES AND 5 REFERRING AND ASSISTING THOSE PERSONS IN LOCATING THE APPROPRIATE STATE AGENCY THAT PROVIDES THE SERVICES REQUESTED OR NEEDED; TO PROVIDE THAT THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES COORDINATOR SHALL BE A PERSON 6 7 WHO IS KNOWLEDGEABLE ABOUT CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE 8 9 STATE; TO REQUIRE THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE TO MAINTAIN A TOLL-FREE 10 TELEPHONE NUMBER DEDICATED SOLELY FOR THE USE OF THE CHILDREN'S 11 SERVICES COORDINATOR; TO DIRECT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PREPARE A PAMPHLET DESCRIBING CHILDREN'S SERVICES THAT ARE 12 13 PROVIDED BY STATE AGENCIES, WHICH WILL PROMINENTLY DISPLAY THE 14 TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES COORDINATOR; TO DIRECT 15 THE DEPARTMENT TO DISTRIBUTE THE PAMPHLET TO VARIOUS LOCATIONS TO 16 GET THAT INFORMATION TO PARENTS AND CHILDREN; AND FOR RELATED 17 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 18 19 SECTION 1. (1) The Governor shall appoint or designate one 20 or more persons in his office to be a children's services coordinator, who will have the duty of receiving calls and other 21 22 inquiries from the public related to children's services and 23 referring and otherwise assisting those persons in locating the appropriate state agency or department that provides the services 24 requested or needed by those persons. The children's services 25 coordinator shall be a person who is knowledgeable about 26 27 children's services provided by the state, particularly services provided by the Department of Human Services, the Division of 28 29 Medicaid, the State Department of Health, the Department of Rehabilitation Services, and the Office of Insurance of the 30 Department of Finance and Administration. The Governor's Office 31 shall maintain a toll-free telephone number dedicated solely for 32 33 the use of the children's services coordinator.

- 34 (2) The State Department of Health shall prepare a brochure
- 35 or pamphlet describing children's services that are provided by
- 36 state agencies, and shall prominently display in the brochure or
- 37 pamphlet the telephone number of the children's services
- 38 coordinator in the Governor's Office. The Department of Health
- 39 shall distribute the brochure or pamphlet to county health
- 40 departments, county departments of human services, school
- 41 districts, doctors' offices and other appropriate locations to get
- 42 that information to parents and children.
- 43 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 2000.
