- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Rankin County may
- 9 expend out of any available funds of the county, an amount that
- 10 the board determines is sufficient for the purchase of and use by
- 11 the sheriff's department of the county of radar speed detection
- 12 equipment. If the board of supervisors authorizes the expenditure
- 13 of funds for this purpose, then the Sheriff of Rankin County and
- 14 any duly sworn deputy sheriff of the county may operate and use
- 15 the equipment to enforce the motor vehicle speed limits on any
- 16 public road, street or highway within the county outside the
- 17 corporate limits of any incorporated municipality.
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after its passage.
