## HOUSE BILL NO. 1750 (As Passed the House)

1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 993, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1994, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 916, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1995, TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF D'IBERVILLE RELATING TO THE JURISDICTION AND POWERS TO BE EXERCISED IN OPERATING THE FORMER D'IBERVILLE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. Chapter 993, Local and Private Laws of 1994, as
8	amended by Chapter 916, Local and Private Laws of 1995, is amended
9	as follows:
LO	Section 1. The City of D'Iberville, Mississippi, acting by
L1	and through its governing authorities, is hereby authorized and
L2	empowered to assume the operation and maintenance of the
L3	D'Iberville Water and Sewer System; and, in connection therewith,
L4	such governing authorities are vested with the same jurisdictional
L5	boundaries and powers and authorities as the district and with the
L6	power to assume all liabilities, obligations, assets, duties and
L7	responsibilities of such district. The city shall have such
L8	powers and authority concerning the entire district and its
L9	facilities as are now or hereafter granted by law to
20	municipalities concerning water and sewer systems, including the
21	power to issue revenue bonds and pledge the net revenues from the
22	operation of such facilities. The powers and authority of the
23	City of D'Iberville to serve the entire area of the D'Iberville
24	Water and Sewer System, as expanded before the city's assumption
25	of such system, shall be identical to the powers and authority of
26	the district in operating and maintaining the system, and the city
27	shall be subject to regulation relating to the system only to the

- 28 same extent as the district.
- The City of D'Iberville shall sell to the West Jackson County
- 30 Water and Sewer District that part of the D'Iberville Water and
- 31 Sewer System lying outside of Harrison County at such time that
- 32 the West Jackson County Water and Sewer District can provide like
- 33 service as is presently being provided by the D'Iberville Water
- 34 and Sewer System.
- 35 Section 2. From and after the adoption by the governing
- 36 authorities of the City of D'Iberville of a resolution assuming
- 37 the liabilities, obligations, assets, duties and responsibilities
- 38 of the D'Iberville Water and Sewer System as provided in Section 1
- 39 of this act, the board of commissioners of such system (as such
- 40 board was established pursuant to Chapter 50, Laws of the First
- 41 Extraordinary Session 1964; as amended by Chapter 890, Local and
- 42 Private Laws of 1973; as amended by Chapter 973, Local and Private
- 43 Laws of 1974; as amended by Chapter 962, Local and Private Laws of
- 44 1977; as amended by Chapter 835, Local and Private Laws of 1984;
- 45 as amended by Chapter 922, Local and Private Laws of 1987) shall
- 46 continue in existence only for the purpose of winding up the
- 47 affairs of the district and for the purpose of taking all
- 48 necessary steps to implement the resolution of the City of
- 49 D'Iberville and its assumption of the district as provided for in
- 50 this act. However, the commissioners of the D'Iberville Water and
- 51 Sewer District shall not continue in existence for a period longer
- 52 than thirty (30) days after the adoption of such resolution,
- 53 except that the Board of Supervisors of Harrison County may extend
- 54 the existence of the district for the purposes set forth in this
- 55 section for up to two (2) additional thirty (30) day periods,
- 56 after which the board of commissioners and the district shall be
- 57 terminated and dissolved.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 59 and after its passage.
