- 20 member and Dean Emeritus of the Vicksburg Center of the
- 21 Mississippi Baptist Seminary, a retired trustee of the Hinds

- 22 Community College Vicksburg-Warren County campus, a board member
- 23 of the Warren County Missionary Baptist Association and the
- 24 General Missionary Baptist Mississippi Convention, a former Vice
- 25 President of the Progressive Baptist Mississippi Convention, a
- 26 member of the Warren County Election Commission staff, a former
- 27 President of the Warren County Minister Alliance and a member of
- 28 the D.W. Simmons Brotherhood Relief Club; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Dr. Lassiter is survived by his lovely wife, Ethel,
- 30 10 children, 15 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren; and
