HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 56
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE AND
2 ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF HINDS COUNTY COURT JUDGE C.A. "CHET" HENLEY,
3 AND EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HIS FAMILY UPON HIS PASSING.

4 WHEREAS, Hinds County Court Judge C.A. "Chet" Henley, a
5 native of Jackson, Mississippi, departed this life on Thursday,
6 November 11, 1999, causing great loss to his family and friends;

8 WHEREAS, after graduating from Byram High School, Judge
9 Henley earned his bachelor's degree from the University of
10 Mississippi and his doctorate of jurisprudence from the Jackson
11 School of Law in 1972; and

12 WHEREAS, Judge Henley practiced law for 17 years and served
13 as a special master for the Chancery Court and as a Youth Court
14 Referee; and

15 WHEREAS, Judge Henley was elected Hinds County Court Judge in
16 1989, where he presided over county and youth court matters; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition to his duties with the court, Judge
18 Henley was an adjunct professor at Hinds Community College in
19 Raymond and Mississippi College in Clinton; and

20 WHEREAS, Judge Henley is survived by his wife, Karen, his
21 four children and three grandchildren; and

22 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State of Mississippi to
23 recognize outstanding Mississippians such as Judge Henley for his
24 many years of dedication and professionalism in the fields of law
25 and teaching:

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF

27 REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That we do hereby
28 commend the life and accomplishments of Judge C.A. "Chet" Henley
29 and extend our deepest sympathy to his family upon his passing.
