HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 57

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MRS. LEASHA SEGARS UPON  
2 BEING NAMED 1999-2000 LEE COUNTY TEACHER OF THE YEAR.

13 fifth grade at Saltillo Elementary School and moved to the fourth  
14 grade the next year, remaining there for the past 5 years; and

15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Segars has been lovingly supported in all her  
16 endeavors by her husband, Mike, and three children, Lindsay,  
17 Dianna and John Michael; and

18 WHEREAS, this Legislature finds it most appropriate to  
19 recognize and commend outstanding educators such as Mrs. Leasha  
20 Segars, a teacher dedicated to guiding the young people of this  
21 state, who are its future:

23 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
