HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 61
(As Adopted by House)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MISS MARIBETH PORTER ON
2 RECEIVING A 2000 PRUDENTIAL SPIRIT OF COMMUNITY AWARD.
