HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 100
(As Adopted by House and Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING DR. CLARA MAE WEATHERSBY
2 FOR HER MANY OUTSTANDING ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

3 WHEREAS, Dr. Clara Mae Weathersby, a native of Hattiesburg,
4 Mississippi, has worked for 36 years as an educator in the
5 Hattiesburg School District as a teacher, counselor, principal,
6 administrator and director; and

7 WHEREAS, in addition, Dr. Weathersby has served 35 years as a
8 Christian educator, serving as an instructor, director, district
9 and state coordinator, academic dean, dean of curriculum and a
10 religious education field worker at Tuskegee Institute in Alabama;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Weathersby has furthered her education by
13 attending higher institutions of learning such as the National
14 School of Missions and Theology in Nashville, Tennessee; Tuskegee
15 Institute in Alabama; Tennessee State University; University of
16 Southern Mississippi and Lift Bible College; and

17 WHEREAS, in 1998, Dr. Weathersby received the Honorary Doctor
18 of Humane Letters Degree from Lift Bible College for her dedicated
19 and committed service to Christian education and secular
20 education; and

21 WHEREAS, Dr. Weathersby is the founder and coordinator of
22 TRIUNE organization that offers Christian education activities to
23 children, youth and adults of the community; and

24 WHEREAS, an active member of her community, Dr. Weathersby is
25 a life member of the NAACP, an officer for the AARP, the National
26 Area Coordinator for Pray USA and Praying and Fasting in South

27 Mississippi, and the Christian Education Director at the Greater
28 Antioch Missionary Baptist Church; and

29 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
30 and commend outstanding Mississippians such as Dr. Weathersby, who
31 has dedicated her career to improving the quality of education for
32 the young people of this state:

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
34 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
35 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Dr. Clara Mae Weathersby for
36 her many outstanding accomplishments and express our heartiest
37 wishes for success in all her future endeavors.
