HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 105

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE
2 PURPOSE OF THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION AND PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL
3 1093, REGULAR SESSION OF 2000, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW
4 SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 55-25-6, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
5 1972, TO REQUIRE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY COUNTIES THAT
6 HAVE ESTABLISHED A RAILS-TO-TRAILS RECREATIONAL DISTRICT TO BE
7 PUBLISHED; TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS, UPON
8 PUBLICATION, SHALL HAVE THE FORCE AND EFFECT OF LAW; TO PROVIDE
9 THAT VIOLATION OF ANY SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL CONSTITUTE
10 A MISDEMEANOR AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR SUCH VIOLATION; TO
11 PROVIDE THAT RECREATIONAL FACILITIES DEVELOPED AND OPERATED BY THE
12 DISTRICT SHALL CONSTITUTE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS AND THAT APPLICABLE
13 RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION
14 AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES SHALL BE ENFORCEABLE ON SUCH FACILITIES;
15 TO RESTRICT THE TYPES OF VEHICLES THAT MAY BE OPERATED ON SUCH
16 RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; TO BRING FORWARD SECTIONS 55-25-1,
17 55-25-3, 55-25-5, 55-25-7, 55-25-9, 55-25-11, 55-25-13 AND
18 55-25-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH RELATE TO THE
19 ESTABLISHMENT BY COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES OF RAILS-TO-TRAILS
20 RECREATIONAL DISTRICTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
22 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That the Joint
23 Rules of the House and the Senate, including all the deadlines and
24 other provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for
25 the purpose of permitting the further consideration and passage of
26 House Bill 1093, Regular Session of 2000, entitled "AN ACT TO
27 CREATE A NEW SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 55-25-6,
28 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED
29 BY COUNTIES THAT HAVE ESTABLISHED A RAILS-TO-TRAILS RECREATIONAL
30 DISTRICT TO BE PUBLISHED; TO PROVIDE THAT SUCH RULES AND
31 REGULATIONS, UPON PUBLICATION, SHALL HAVE THE FORCE AND EFFECT OF
32 LAW; TO PROVIDE THAT VIOLATION OF ANY SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS
33 SHALL CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR SUCH
34 VIOLATION; TO PROVIDE THAT RECREATIONAL FACILITIES DEVELOPED AND
35 OPERATED BY THE DISTRICT SHALL CONSTITUTE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS AND THAT

36 APPLICABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION
37 COMMISSION AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES SHALL BE ENFORCEABLE ON SUCH
38 FACILITIES; TO RESTRICT THE TYPES OF VEHICLES THAT MAY BE OPERATED
39 ON SUCH RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; TO BRING FORWARD SECTIONS
40 55-25-1, 55-25-3, 55-25-5, 55-25-7, 55-25-9, 55-25-11, 55-25-13
41 AND 55-25-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH RELATE TO THE
42 ESTABLISHMENT BY COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES OF RAILS-TO-TRAILS
43 RECREATIONAL DISTRICTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
