HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 118

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE RETIRED TEACHERS AND
2 EMPLOYEES OF THE GREENWOOD SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THEIR YEARS OF
3 DEDICATED SERVICE.

11 District are responsible for having prepared and groomed an entire
12 generation of future doctors, lawyers, nurses, politicians,
13 teachers, leaders, role models and President of the United States
14 to face the challenges and victories that the future holds in
