HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 135

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING MRS. HENRIETTA WASHINGTON
2 GREEN OR HER MANY YEARS OF SERVICE AND CONGRATULATE HER UPON HER
3 RETIREMENT.

4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Henrietta Washington Green will retire after 27
5 years of service to the State of Mississippi with the Holmes
6 County Department of Human Services; and

7 WHEREAS, Mrs. Green, a native of Holmes County, Mississippi,
8 graduated from Ambrose High School and furthered her education
9 with studies at Rust College, Mississippi Valley State University
10 and the University of Mississippi; and

11 WHEREAS, in 1973, Mrs. Green began her service to the people
12 of Holmes County as a clerk in the Economic Assistance Department
13 for the Department of Human Services; and

14 WHEREAS, from 1987 to 1991, Mrs. Green worked as an
15 accounting clerk for the Child Support Department and currently
16 serves as a child support enforcement officer; and

17 WHEREAS, an active member of her community, Mrs. Green is a
18 member of the NAACP, the Lebanon Missionary Baptist Church, where
19 she actively serves on numerous committees including scholarship,
20 finance, senior choir, pulpit, and program committee; and

21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Green has been lovingly supported in all her
22 endeavors by her late husband, Mr. William H. Green; her five
23 children, Connie, Belinda Kaye, Ronnie, Janice, Bessie; and eight
24 grandchildren; and

25 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
26 and commend outstanding service such as that of Mrs. Green, who

27 has dedicated 27 years of service to the citizens of Holmes
28 County:

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
30 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING
31 THEREIN, That we do hereby commend Mrs. Henrietta Washington Green
32 for her 27 years of service and congratulate her upon her
33 retirement.
