- 22 Shell Noreast, Shell's oil and gas operations in the State of

- 25 Shell's asset manager for producing operations in the Eastern Gulf
- 26 of Mexico; and

- 27 WHEREAS, in 1991, the College of Engineering at Mississippi
- 28 State University named 100 Distinguished Engineering Fellows as
- 29 part of the celebration of the college's 100th anniversary; and
- 30 WHEREAS, the program was reborn in 1999 with an addition of
- 31 10 new Distinguished Engineering Fellows, and eight more alumni
- 32 were added in 2000 including Mr. Purvis; and
