HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 29
(As Adopted by House)

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF MR.
2 CURTIS HOLSTON AND EXPRESSING DEEPEST SYMPATHY TO HIS FAMILY AND
3 FRIENDS UPON HIS PASSING.

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Curtis Holston, a native of Poplarville,
5 Mississippi, departed this life on April 18, 2000, causing a great
6 loss to his family and friends; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Holston, son of the late Curtis and Verma
8 Amacker Holston, was born on February 18, 1939; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Holston served the people of the State of
10 Mississippi as a member of the House of Representatives for eight
11 years; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Holston worked for an oil field industry and as
13 a farmer; and

14 WHEREAS, an active member of his community, Mr. Holston was a
15 member of the First Baptist Church of Poplarville, Mississippi;

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Holston is survived by his wife, Virginia Greer
18 Holston; three children, Victoria, John Curtis and Sam; five
19 grandchildren and many extended family members; and

20 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives of
21 the State of Mississippi to recognize and commend outstanding
22 Mississippians such as Mr. Curtis Holston:
