## SENATE BILL NO. 2081 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE 1 LICENSE PLATES OR TAGS TO OWNERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES WHO HAVE 3 OBTAINED THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA OR WHO HAVE RECEIVED THE HIGHEST RANKING RECOGNIZED BY THE GIRL 5 SCOUTS OF AMERICA; TO PRESCRIBE THE FORM OF SUCH TAGS OR PLATES; TO ESTABLISH THE FEE FOR SUCH TAGS OR PLATES; AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. (1) The owner of a motor vehicle who has 10 achieved the rank of Eagle Scout in the Boy Scouts of America or who has received the Gold Award which is the highest ranking in 11 Girl Scouting as recognized by the Girl Scouts of America, upon 12 complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and 13 14 licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the road and 15 bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 16 17 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount of Fifteen Dollars 18 (\$15.00), shall be privileged to obtain one (1) distinctive motor 19 20 vehicle license plate or tag identifying him as an Eagle Scout or a recipient of the Gold Award. 21 22 (2) The distinctive <u>Eagle Scout</u> plates or tags shall be of a color and design designated by the State Tax Commission; provided, 23 24 however, that the Eagle Scout emblem shall be displayed on the tag

or plate. The emblem shall be affixed during the production of

the license plate or tag. The distinctive Gold Award plates or

tags shall be of a color or design as designated by the State Tax

Commission.

- 29 (3) Application for the special license tags or plates shall
- 30 be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the
- 31 State Tax Commission. An applicant for such distinctive plates or
- 32 tags shall present to the county such written evidence of the
- 33 applicant's rank of Eagle Scout or such applicant's receipt of the
- 34 Girl Scout's Gold Award as may be considered satisfactory by the
- 35 State Tax Commission. The application and the additional fee,
- 36 less five percent (5%) thereof to be retained by the tax
- 37 collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a
- 38 monthly basis as prescribed by the commission and shall be
- 39 deposited to the credit of the State General Fund. The portion of
- 40 the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be
- 41 deposited into the county general fund.
- 42 (4) The special license tag shall be issued for a one-year
- 43 period. The additional annual fee shall be due and payable at the
- 44 time of renewal registration.
- 45 (5) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 46 State Treasury on the day received. At the end of each month, the
- 47 State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected under
- 48 this section to the State Treasurer.
- 49 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 2000.
