- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The constable shall have power, upon
- 6 approval of the board of supervisors of the county, to appoint one
- 7 or more deputies, who shall take the oath of office and may give
- 8 bond, and who thereupon shall have power to do and perform all the
- 9 acts and duties which their principal may lawfully do; such
- 10 approval, when given by the board of supervisors of the county,
- 11 shall be in writing, and shall be entered on its minutes.
- 12 (2) Each deputy constable, before he enters upon the duties
- 13 of the appointment, shall take the oath of office, and may give
- 14 bond, with sufficient surety, to be payable, conditioned and
- 15 approved as provided by law, in a penalty equal to Twenty-five
- 16 Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00). The board of supervisors of the
- 17 county, in its discretion, may pay the bond on behalf of the
- 18 deputy constable.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2000.
