## SENATE BILL NO. 2228

AN ACT TO EXEMPT EGG HOUSES, PULLET HOUSES AND BROILER HOUSES
 FROM AD VALOREM TAXATION FOR A PERIOD OF TEN YEARS BEGINNING
 OCTOBER 1, 2000; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
<u>SECTION 1.</u> From and after October 1, 2000, through September
30, 2010, all egg houses, pullet houses and broiler houses shall
be exempt from all ad valorem taxation, except ad valorem taxes
for school district purposes.

SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall affect or defeat any 9 10 claim, assessment, appeal, suit, right or cause of action for taxes due or accrued under the ad valorem tax laws before the date 11 on which this act becomes effective, whether such claims, 12 assessments, appeals, suits or actions have been begun before the 13 date on which this act becomes effective or are begun thereafter; 14 15 and the provisions of the ad valorem tax laws are expressly continued in full force, effect and operation for the purpose of 16 the assessment, collection and enrollment of liens for any taxes 17 due or accrued and the execution of any warrant under such laws 18 19 before the date on which this act becomes effective, and for the 20 imposition of any penalties, forfeitures or claims for failure to 21 comply with such laws.
