## SENATE BILL NO. 2286

- AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 15-1-40, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1
- 2 TO PROVIDE A STATUTE OF REPOSE FOR LAND SURVEYORS ENGAGED IN THE
- 3 PRACTICE OF LAND SURVEYING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15-1-40, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- codified as follows: 6
- 7 15-1-40. No action to recover damages for any deficiency,
- 8 defect, omission, error or miscalculation in a survey or plat
- shall be brought against a professional land surveyor, or the 9
- 10 employee of a professional land surveyor, who performed or
- 11 furnished the survey or plat unless it is filed within six (6)
- years from the date of the survey or plat. The cause of action in 12
- 13 such cases shall accrue when services are rendered as shown from
- the date on the survey or plat or the date of a supplement or 14
- 15 amendment to the survey or plat. Any action not instituted within
- the period provided by this section shall be forever barred. 16
- In the event the cause of action shall have been fraudulently 17
- concealed from the knowledge of the person entitled thereto, the 18
- cause of action shall be deemed to have first accrued at, and not 19
- 20 before, the time at which such fraud shall be, or with reasonable
- 21 diligence should have been, first known or discovered.

- For the purposes of this section, "professional land
- 23 surveyor" shall be as defined in Section 73-13-71.
- 24 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after its passage.
