1	AN	ACT	TO	AMEND	SECTION	67-3-53,	MISSISSIPPI	CODE	OF	1972,	TO

- 2 PROHIBIT THE HOLDER OF A PERMIT AUTHORIZING THE RETAIL SALE OF
- 3 BEER OR LIGHT WINE FROM ALLOWING THE CONSUMPTION OF BEER OR LIGHT
- 4 WINE ON THE RETAIL PREMISES AFTER THE HOURS IT IS LEGALLY OPEN FOR
- 5 BUSINESS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 67-3-53, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 67-3-53. In addition to any act declared to be unlawful by
- 10 this chapter, or by Sections 27-71-301 through 27-71-347, and
- 11 Sections 67-3-17, 67-3-27, 67-3-29 and 67-3-57, it shall be
- 12 unlawful for the holder of a permit authorizing the sale of beer
- 13 or light wine at retail or for the employee of the holder of such
- 14 a permit:
- 15 (a) To sell, give or permit to be consumed in or upon
- 16 any licensed premises any beer or light wine between the hours of
- 17 midnight and seven o'clock the following morning or during any
- 18 time the licensed premises may be required to be closed by
- 19 municipal ordinance or order of the board of supervisors;
- 20 provided, however, in areas where the sale of alcoholic beverages
- 21 is legal under the provisions of the Local Option Alcoholic
- 22 Beverage Control Law and the hours for selling such alcoholic

- 23 beverages have been extended beyond midnight for on-premises
- 24 permittees under Section 67-1-37, the hours for selling beer or
- 25 light wines are likewise extended in areas where the sale of beer
- 26 and light wines is legal in accordance with the provisions of this
- 27 chapter.
- 28 (b) To sell, give or furnish any beer or light wine to
- 29 any person visibly or noticeably intoxicated, or to any insane
- 30 person, or to any habitual drunkard, or to any person under the
- 31 age of twenty-one (21) years.
- 32 (c) To permit in the premises any lewd, immoral or
- 33 improper entertainment, conduct or practices.
- 34 (d) To permit loud, boisterous or disorderly conduct of
- 35 any kind upon the premises or to permit the use of loud musical
- 36 instruments if either or any of the same may disturb the peace and
- 37 quietude of the community wherein such business is located.
- 38 (e) To permit persons of ill repute, known criminals,
- 39 prostitutes or minors to frequent the licensed premises, except
- 40 minors accompanied by parents or guardians, or under proper
- 41 supervision.
- 42 (f) To permit or suffer illegal gambling or the
- 43 operation of illegal games of chance upon the licensed premises.
- 44 (g) To receive, possess or sell on the licensed
- 45 premises any beverage of any kind or character containing more
- 46 than five percent (5%) of alcohol by weight unless the licensee
- 47 also possesses an on-premises permit under the Local Option
- 48 Alcoholic Beverage Control Law.
- 49 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 2000.
