- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) For the purposes of this section, a "gun
- 5 show" is an event or function sponsored by any individual or
- 6 corporation or any national, state or local organization that is
- 7 devoted to the collection, competitive use, or other sporting use
- 8 of firearms, or an organization that sponsors functions devoted to
- 9 the collection, competitive use, or other sporting use of firearms
- 10 in the community.
- 11 (2) It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of
- 12 eighteen (18) to attend any gun show.
- 13 (3) Violation of this section shall constitute a misdemeanor
- 14 for any adult who permits such violation, and an act of
- 15 delinquency for any child over the age of thirteen (13) who is
- 16 found to be in attendance at a gun show.
- 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2000.
