- 7 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 43-39-12, Mississippi Code of 1972: 8
- 9 43-39-12. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this
- section, a displaced person shall not be eligible to receive 10
- 11 relocation payments or any other assistance under this chapter if
- 12 the displaced person is an alien not lawfully present in the
- 13 United States.
- 14 (2) If a displacing agency determines by clear and
- convincing evidence that a determination of the ineligibility of a 15
- displaced person under subsection (1) of this section would result 16
- 17 in exceptional and extremely unusual hardship to an individual who
- 18 is the displaced person's spouse, parent, or child and who is a
- 19 citizen of the United States or an alien lawfully admitted for
- permanent residence in the United States, the displacing agency 20
- 21 shall provide relocation payments and other assistance to the
- 22 displaced person under this chapter if the displaced person would

- 23 be eligible for the assistance but for subsection (1) of this
- 24 section.
- 25 (3) The Mississippi Transportation Commission shall adopt
- 26 such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the
- 27 provisions of this section and in order to comply with federal
- 28 law.
- 29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 30 and after July 1, 2000.
