6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. Section 65-1-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:[JWB1]
9	65-1-51. The Mississippi <u>Transportation</u> Commission <u>may</u>
10	acquire by gift, purchase or otherwise, and \underline{may} have the
11	Mississippi Department of Transportation improve and maintain
12	strips of land necessary for the restoration, preservation and
13	enhancement of scenic beauty adjacent to the state highway
14	rights-of-way. The commission may acquire and have the
15	Transportation Department develop publicly owned and controlled
16	rest and recreation areas and sanitary and other facilities within
17	or adjacent to the highway right-of-way reasonably necessary to
18	accommodate the traveling public.
19	The Mississippi Transportation Commission, in its discretion,
20	may acquire by gift, purchase or otherwise, including the exercise
21	of eminent domain, public or privately owned wetlands and other
22	lands suitable for creation as wetlands for the purpose of
23	mitigating wetland losses and replacing those wetlands purchased
24	and damaged or eliminated by development and use, on a basis not
25	to exceed that required by the Federal Highway Administration as a
26	condition for receiving federal aid funds, provided that some
27	governmental agency or approved organization agrees, without

- 29 such lands as wetlands in perpetuity. However, the commission
- 30 shall replace those coastal wetlands purchased and damaged or
- 31 eliminated by development and use on the basis required by the
- 32 "Coastal Wetlands Protection Law" and regulations promulgated
- 33 thereunder by the Mississippi Commission on Marine Resources.
- 34 <u>The Mississippi Transportation Commission, in its discretion,</u>
- 35 may acquire by gift, purchase or otherwise, wetlands credits from
- 36 <u>an approved organization with a plan establishing a wetland</u>
- 37 <u>mitigation bank. The commission shall, if possible, purchase</u>
- 38 <u>credits on wetlands within the State of Mississippi before</u>
- 39 purchasing credits on wetlands located outside the State of
- 40 <u>Mississippi</u>.
- 41 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 2000.
