- 2 PROHIBIT POSSESSION OF A HANDGUN; TO REPEAL SECTION 97-37-14,
- 3 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH DESIGNATES POSSESSION OF A HANDGUN
- 4 BY A MINOR AS A DELINQUENT ACT; TO REPEAL SECTION 45-9-101,
- 5 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH ENACTS A LICENSE TO CARRY A
- 6 CONCEALED PISTOL OR REVOLVER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 97-37-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 97-37-1. (1) \* \* \* Any person who carries, concealed in
- 11 whole or in part, any bowie knife, dirk knife, butcher knife,
- 12 switchblade knife, metallic knuckles, blackjack, slingshot \* \* \*
- 13 or any rifle with a barrel of less than sixteen (16) inches in
- 14 length, or any shotgun with a barrel of less than eighteen (18)
- 15 inches in length, machine gun or any fully automatic firearm or
- 16 deadly weapon, or any muffler or silencer for any firearm, whether
- 17 or not it is accompanied by a firearm, or uses or attempts to use
- 18 against another person any imitation firearm, or carries,
- 19 <u>concealed or openly, any pistol, revolver or other handgun, shall</u>
- 20 upon conviction be punished as follows:
- 21 (a) By a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars
- 22 (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by
- 23 imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6) months,

- 24 or both, in the discretion of the court, for the first conviction
- 25 under this section.
- 26 (b) By a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars
- 27 (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and
- 28 imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty (30) days
- 29 nor more than six (6) months, for the second conviction under this
- 30 section.
- 31 (c) By imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for not
- 32 less than one (1) year nor more than five (5) years, for the third
- 33 or more convictions under this section.
- 34 (d) By imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for not
- 35 less than one (1) year nor more than five (5) years for any person
- 36 previously convicted of any felony who is convicted under this
- 37 section.
- 38 (2) It shall not be a violation of this section for any
- 39 person over the age of eighteen (18) years to carry a firearm or
- 40 deadly weapon that is not a pistol, revolver or other handgun
- 41 concealed in whole or in part within the confines of his own home
- 42 or his place of business, or any real property associated with his
- 43 home or business or within any motor vehicle.
- 44 (3) It shall not be a violation of this section for any
- 45 person to carry a firearm or deadly weapon that is not a pistol,
- 46 <u>revolver or other handgun</u> concealed in whole or in part if the
- 47 possessor of the weapon is then engaged in a legitimate
- 48 weapon-related sports activity or is going to or returning from
- 49 such activity. For purposes of this subsection, "legitimate
- 50 weapon-related sports activity" means hunting, fishing, target
- 51 shooting or any other legal sports activity which normally
- 52 involves the use of a firearm or other weapon.
- 53 SECTION 2. Section 97-37-14, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
- 54 designates possession of a handgun by a minor as a delinquent act,

- 55 is repealed.
- SECTION 3. Section 45-9-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, which
- 57 provides for a license to carry a concealed pistol or revolver, is
- 58 repealed.
- 59 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 60 and after July 1, 2000.
