SENATE BILL NO. 2541

1           AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL  
2 FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF DISTRICT ATTORNEYS AND ASSISTANT  
3 DISTRICT ATTORNEYS OF THE STATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000.

4           BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5           SECTION 1. In addition to all others sums heretofore  
6 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of  
9 defraying the expenses of district attorneys and assistant  
10 district attorneys of the state, for the fiscal year ending  
11 June 30, 2000.....\$    734,923.00.

12           SECTION 2. The funds appropriated under the provisions of  
13 Section 1 are allocated for the following purposes:

14           (a) Salaries and expenses of District Attorneys,  
15               Assistant District Attorneys and Criminal  
16               Investigators.....\$    731,301.00.

17           (b) Tort Claims Assessment.....\$       3,622.00.

18           Total.....\$    734,923.00.

19           SECTION 3. This additional appropriation is made for the  
20 purpose of paying for salary increases for Criminal Investigators  
21 as authorized in Senate Bill No. 2479, 1999 Regular Session;

22   Paying for an additional Legal Assistant for the Second Circuit  
23   Court District as authorized by House Bill No. 771, 1999 Regular  
24   Session; Paying the increases in state health insurance premiums,  
25   workers' compensation rate and FICA ceiling for District  
26   Attorneys' salaries; and for the increase in the Tort Claims Fund  
27   assessment for fiscal year 2000.

28           SECTION 4.   The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
29   the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds  
30   as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal  
31   Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants  
32   upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers  
33   in the manner provided by law.

34           SECTION 5.   This act shall take effect and be in force from  
35   and after its passage.
