- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-313, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[LTR1]
- 7 49-15-313. (1) Any resident between the ages of sixteen
- (16) and sixty-five (65) years, as defined in Section 49-7-3, 8
- 9 fishing in the marine waters of the state, shall obtain a
- 10 saltwater sports fishing license for a fee of Four Dollars
- (\$4.00). This license shall be valid in any waters south of 11
- 12 Interstate 10. Any resident citizen who is blind, paraplegic or a
- 13 multiple amputee, or who has been adjudged by the Veterans
- Administration as having a total service-connected disability, or 14
- has been adjudged totally disabled by the Social Security 15
- Administration shall not be required to purchase or have in his 16
- possession a saltwater sports fishing license while engaged in 17
- such activities. Any resident exempt under this section shall 18
- have on his person while fishing proof of residency and age or 19
- 20 disability.
- 21 (2) The commission shall prescribe the forms, types and fees
- for nonresident saltwater sports fishing licenses except that the 22
- fee for a nonresident saltwater sports fishing license shall not 23
- be less than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). The commission shall 24
- require a nonresident to purchase a nonresident freshwater fishing 25
- license and a nonresident saltwater sports fishing license if the 26

- 27 nonresident's state requires both licenses for a nonresident to
- 28 fish in its marine waters.
- 29 (3) All <u>resident</u> vessels engaged in charter boat fishing,
- 30 party boat fishing, head boat and guide boat fishing shall be
- 31 issued a separate annual license by the commission at a fee of Two
- 32 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). All nonresident vessels engaged in
- 33 <u>charter boat fishing, party boat fishing, headboat and guide boat</u>
- 34 <u>fishing shall be issued a separate annual license by the</u>
- 35 <u>commission at a fee of Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00)</u>. If the
- 36 <u>applicant's domicile state charges a greater fee than the</u>
- 37 <u>nonresident fee of Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) for residents</u>
- 38 of Mississippi, then the applicant must pay the same fee that the
- 39 <u>applicant's domicile state charges a resident of Mississippi.</u>
- 40 Crew members and customers of the licensed vessels shall not be
- 41 required to purchase an individual resident or nonresident
- 42 saltwater fishing license while sponsored by the licensed vessels.
- 43 An operator of a licensed vessel shall be required to report the
- 44 number of customers to the department as required by the
- 45 commission and the information shall be kept confidential and
- 46 shall not be released, except to other fisheries management
- 47 agencies or as statistical data.
- 48 (4) The saltwater sports fishing license is required for all
- 49 <u>recreational methods of finfish harvest</u>.
- 50 (5) Any resident who purchases a lifetime sportsman's
- 51 license, in accordance with Section 49-7-153, shall be entitled to
- 52 fish in the marine salt waters of the state and shall be exempt
- 53 from the purchase of a sport saltwater fishing license.
- 54 (6) Any person authorized to issue a license may collect and
- 55 retain, for each saltwater fishing license issued, the additional
- 56 fee authorized under Section 49-7-17.
- 57 (7) The fees collected from the sale of resident and
- 58 nonresident saltwater sports fishing licenses shall be deposited
- 59 into the Seafood Fund and shall be used solely for the management
- 60 of marine resources.
- 61 (8) Participants in the Very Special Fishing Olympics are
- 62 exempt from this section.
- 63 (9) July 4 of each year is designated as "Free Saltwater

- 64 Sports Fishing Day." Any person may saltwater sport fish without
- 65 a license on the "Free Saltwater Sports Fishing Day."
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 67 and after July 1, 2000.
