The county administrator of each county of the 29 30 State of Mississippi shall prepare and submit to the board of supervisors at its August meeting of each year a complete budget 31 32 of revenues, expenses and a working cash balance estimated for the next fiscal year, which shall be based on the aggregate funds 33 34 estimated to be available for the ensuing fiscal year for each fund, from which such estimated expenses will be paid, exclusive 35 of school maintenance funds, which shall be shown separately and 36 37 exclusive of the budget of the sheriff's department which shall be prepared by the sheriff. The statement of revenues shall show 38 39 every source of revenue along with the amount derived from each 40 source. The budget, including the sheriff's budget, containing the statement of revenues and expenses shall be published at least 41 one (1) time during the month of August, with such publication of 42 43 the budget being at least three (3) days before approval by the 44 board, in a newspaper published in the county, or if no newspaper
