## SENATE BILL NO. 2630

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 93-17-12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO DIRECT A FEE TO BE IMPOSED FOR COURT ORDER HOME STUDIES IN
- 3 CHILD CUSTODY MATTERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 93-17-12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[RDD1]
- 7 93-17-12. In any child custody matter hereafter filed in any
- 8 chancery or county court, the court may impose a fee for any
- 9 court-ordered home study performed by the Department of Human
- 10 Services. The fee  $\underline{\text{shall}}$  be assessed upon either party or upon
- 11 both parties in the court's discretion. The  $\underline{\text{minimum}}$  fee  $\underline{\text{imposed}}$
- 12 <u>shall be not less than</u> Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) <u>for</u>
- 13 <u>each household on which a home study is performed</u>. The fee shall
- 14 be paid to the department at a time specified by the court.
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after July 1, 2000.
