- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The owner of a motor vehicle who has
- 8 achieved the rank of Eagle Scout in the Boy Scouts of America,
- 9 upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to
- 10 registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of
- 11 the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and
- 12 registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of
- 13 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,
- 14 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount of
- 15 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00), shall be privileged to obtain one (1)
- 16 distinctive motor vehicle license plate or tag identifying him as
- 17 an Eagle Scout.
- 18 (2) The distinctive plates or tags shall be of a color and
- 19 design designated by the State Tax Commission; provided, however,
- 20 that the Eagle Scout emblem shall be displayed on the tag or
- 21 plate. The emblem shall be affixed during the production of the
- 22 license plate or tag.
- 23 (3) Application for the special license tags or plates shall
- 24 be made to the county tax collector on forms prescribed by the
- 25 State Tax Commission. An applicant for such distinctive plates or
- 26 tags shall present to the county such written evidence of the
- 27 applicant's rank of Eagle Scout as may be considered satisfactory

- 28 by the State Tax Commission. The application and the additional
- 29 fee, less five percent (5%) thereof to be retained by the tax
- 30 collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a
- 31 monthly basis as prescribed by the commission and shall be
- 32 deposited to the credit of the State General Fund. The portion of
- 33 the additional fee retained by the tax collector shall be
- 34 deposited into the county general fund.
- 35 (4) The special license tag shall be issued for a one-year
- 36 period. The additional annual fee shall be due and payable at the
- 37 time of renewal registration.
- 38 (5) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
- 39 State Treasury on the day received. At the end of each month, the
- 40 State Tax Commission shall certify the total fees collected under
- 41 this section to the State Treasurer.
- 42 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 2000.
