## SENATE BILL NO. 2786

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-3-40, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXPAND AND CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS TO ADOPT
- 3 AND ENFORCE ORDERS, RESOLUTIONS OR ORDINANCES WITH RESPECT TO
- 4 COUNTY AFFAIRS, PROPERTY AND FINANCES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 19-3-40, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:[JWB1]
- 8 19-3-40. \* \* \* The board of supervisors of any county shall
- 9 have the power to adopt <u>and enforce</u> any orders, resolutions or
- 10 ordinances with respect to county affairs, property and finances,
- 11 which do not specifically conflict with the Mississippi
- 12 Constitution, the Mississippi Code of 1972, or any other statute
- 13 or law of the State of Mississippi; and any such board shall
- 14 likewise have the power to alter, modify and repeal such orders,
- 15 resolutions or ordinances. Except as otherwise provided in
- 16 subsection (2) of this section, the powers granted to boards of
- 17 supervisors in this section are complete without the existence of
- 18 or reference to any specific authority granted in any other
- 19 statute or law of the State of Mississippi.
- Such orders, resolutions or ordinances shall apply countywide
- 21 except when the governing authorities of any municipality situated
- 22 within a county adopt any order, resolution or ordinance governing
- 23 the same general subject matter. In such case the municipal
- 24 order, resolution or ordinance shall govern within the corporate
- 25 limits of the municipality.
