SENATE BILL NO. 2788 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-29-313, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE POSSESSION OF PRECURSORS OF METHAMPHETAMINE 1 2 3 PRODUCTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. (1) (a) Except as authorized in this section, 8 it is unlawful for any person to knowingly or intentionally: 9 Purchase, possess, transfer or distribute any (i) two (2) or more of the listed * * * chemicals or precursor drugs 10 in any amount with the intent to unlawfully manufacture a 11 12 controlled substance; 13 (ii) Purchase, possess, transfer or distribute any two (2) or more of the listed * * * chemicals or precursor drugs 14 15 in any amount, knowing * * * that the listed * * * chemical or precursor drug will be used to unlawfully manufacture a controlled 16 17 substance; Any person who violates this subsection (1), upon 18 19 conviction, is guilty of a felony and may be imprisoned for a period not to exceed thirty (30) years and shall be fined not less 20 than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) nor more than One Million 21 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), or both fine and imprisonment. 22
