- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-3-1009, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:[CSQ1]
- 9 63-3-1009. (1) The <u>Transportation Commission shall</u> \* \* \*
- 10 erect stop signs at all otherwise unregulated highway grade
- 11 <u>crossings of railroads</u>. When such stop signs are erected the
- 12 driver of any vehicle shall stop within fifty feet but not less
- 13 than ten feet from the nearest track of such grade crossing and
- 14 shall proceed only upon exercise of due care. No stop need be
- 15 <u>made at any such crossing where a police officer or a traffic</u>
- 16 <u>control signal directs traffic to proceed.</u>
- 17 (2) Violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor
- 18 punishable upon conviction by a fine of Two Hundred Dollars
- 19 (\$200.00).
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2000.
