1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AT THE GENERAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER, 2003, VOTERS MAY EXPRESS THEIR PREFERENCE REGARDING THE CONTINUED USE OF THE CURRENT STATE FLAG OR THE ADOPTION OF THE STATE FLAG AS IT EXISTED IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE ADOPTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. (1) At the general election to be held in
8	November, 2003, there shall be printed on the ballot the
9	following:

11	"For the continued use of the current state flag
12	
13	For the adoption of the state flag as it existed immediately
14	prior to the adoption of the Mississippi Constitution of
15	1890"
16	
17	The qualified electors may indicate their preference by
18	putting a cross (x) or check (b) mark opposite the words that
19	express their preference.
20	The preference of a majority of the qualified electors shall
21	be a mandate to the Legislature to take whatever steps are
22	necessary to follow such preference.
23	(2) The county election commissioners shall transmit to the
24	Secretary of State, in the same manner as the vote for state
25	officers is transmitted, a statement of the total number of votes
26	cast for each proposition. The Secretary of State shall tabulate
27	such returns and certify the results to the Governor and to each

- 29 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 30 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 31 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 32 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 33 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 34 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 35 extended.
- 36 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 38 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
