SENATE BILL NO. 3148

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO PROHIBIT OR
2 RESTRICT OUTDOOR BURNING DURING DROUGHT CONDITIONS; TO PROVIDE
3 THAT THE STATE FORESTRY COMMISSION SHALL DETERMINE IF SUCH DROUGHT
4 CONDITIONS EXISTS; TO PROVIDE PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS; AND FOR
5 RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. (1) In this section, "drought conditions" means
8 the existence of a long-term deficit of moisture creating severe
9 conditions with increased wildfire occurrences as determined by
10 the State Forestry Commission through use of drought indices or
11 models.

12 (2) If the State Forestry Commission determines that drought
13 conditions exist in a county, the commission shall notify the
14 board of supervisors of that county. The commission may recommend
15 that a temporary outdoor burning ban or other restrictions be
16 adopted by the board of supervisors. The State Forestry
17 Commission shall notify the board of supervisors when the drought
18 conditions no longer exist.

19 (3) The board of supervisors may, by order, prohibit or
20 restrict outdoor burning in all or part of the unincorporated
21 parts of the county if drought conditions have been determined to
22 exist by the State Forestry Commission. An order must specify the
23 period during which burning is restricted. Any order issued under
24 this section shall expire upon the determination that the drought
25 conditions no longer exist.

26 (4) Any person who knowingly and willfully violates an order
27 under this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and may be fined not

28 less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred
29 Dollars (\$500.00).

30 (5) The sheriff of the county shall enforce the order and
31 may cite persons for violations of an order under this section.

32 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
33 and after its passage.
