SENATE BILL NO. 3249  
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE  
2 DEPARTMENT, BEING THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND STAFF, AND FOR  
3 EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE PROPER OPERATION OF THE GOVERNOR'S  
4 MANSION AND RESIDENCE OF THE GOVERNOR, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for expenses of the  
9 Executive Department, being the Governor's office and staff, for  
10 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001,  
11 .....\$ 2,400,273.00.

12 SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions  
13 of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

19 Any escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms,  
20 conditions, and procedures established by law.

21 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
22 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are  
23 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this  
24 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

25 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
26 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State  
27 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for expenses incidental

28 to the proper operation of the Governor's Mansion and residence of  
29 the Governor for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and  
30 ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 617,291.00.

31 SECTION 4. With the funds appropriated under the provisions  
32 of Section 3, the following positions are authorized:

38 Any escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms,  
39 conditions, and procedures established by law.

40 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
41 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are  
42 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this  
43 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

44 SECTION 5. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
45 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State  
46 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Executive  
47 Department, being the Governor's office and staff, for the purpose  
48 of reauthorizing the expenditure of State General Funds, as  
49 authorized in Senate Bill No. 3129, Regular Session of 1999, for  
50 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001  
51 .....\$ 300,000.00.

52 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the  
53 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended  
54 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000.

55 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
56 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the  
57 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon  
58 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal  
59 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the  
60 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

61           SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from  
62 and after July 1, 2000.
