SENATE BILL NO. 3263
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE
2 TREASURY FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI
3 FARMERS CENTRAL MARKET, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central
8 Market, to defray the expenses of said Farmers Central Market and
9 to provide for the payment of any indebtedness which may accrue
10 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
11 June 30, 2001.....\$ 461,526.00.

12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15 expenditure:

16 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:

17 Personal Services:

32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the
38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
42 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
45 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
46 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
47 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
48 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"
49 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
50 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
51 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

53 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
54 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

55 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

59 Provided, however, that all funds received from any and all

60 sources shall be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury
61 to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central Market.

62 SECTION 3. The board shall promulgate and adopt reasonable
63 rules and regulations, including employing attendants, to regulate
64 and provide for the parking of motor vehicles at the farm produce
65 marketing facility near the Mississippi Memorial Stadium for
66 regularly scheduled football games, and said board shall make said
67 facility available for such purpose and shall make a reasonable
68 charge therefor comparable to the charge made for parking in the
69 area contiguous to the stadium. The net proceeds from such
70 parking shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of
71 the Mississippi Farmers Central Market and shall be used solely
72 for general maintenance and repair of the Central Market
73 facilities.

74 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
75 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
76 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
77 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
78 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
79 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

80 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
81 and after July 1, 2000.
