1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE FOREST HIGH SCHOOL
2 BEARCATS FOOTBALL TEAM FOR WINNING THE STATE CLASS 3A FOOTBALL
3 CHAMPIONSHIP AND BEING THE NO. 1 RANKED FOOTBALL TEAM IN CLASS 3A.

4 WHEREAS, the Forest High School Bearcats football team won
5 the 1999 State Class 3A Football Championship; and

6 WHEREAS, the Forest Bearcats finished the season as the No. 1
7 football team in the State of Mississippi in Class 3A; and

8 WHEREAS, in the Bearcats' march to the championship, the team
9 rallied to come from behind in the last three play-off games,
10 including the championship game; and

11 WHEREAS, the Bearcats finished with a record of 12 wins and 2
12 losses; and

13 WHEREAS, the tenacious defense of the Bearcats shut out five
14 opponents; and

15 WHEREAS, the resiliency and tenacity shown by the Bearcats
16 are characteristic of championship teams; and

17 WHEREAS, the Bearcats were superbly coached and led by Head
18 Coach Jack French and Assistant Coaches Kevin Worrell, Don Stokes,
19 Allan Atkison, Tommy Davis, Roy Pinkston and Tim White; and

20 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Legislature to commend
21 meritorious accomplishments, especially when achieved by the youth

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
24 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
