Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting 8 in lieu thereof the following:

- 10 SECTION 1. Section 7-7-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11amended as follows:
- 7-7-41. The State Fiscal Officer may promulgate such 13 regulations and procedures as he may deem necessary in regard to 14 preauditing and postauditing claims and issuing warrants covering 15 payments for construction contracts entered into by the 16 Mississippi Department of Transportation, the Department of 17 Finance and Administration, the State Department of Education, or 18 by any other agency now existing or hereafter created, having 19 control and supervision of the awarding and payment of 20 construction contracts.
- 21 The State Fiscal Officer shall * * * prescribe rules and 22 regulations concerning the preauditing and postauditing of claims 23 and the issuance of warrants and other forms of payments for all 24 departments, institutions and agencies of the state, more 25 particularly those coming within the provisions of Sections 7-9-41 26 and 7-9-43, after full discussion with the fiscal officers 27 thereof, to the end that the most efficient overall state 28 accounting system may be maintained. Such regulations, however, 29 shall be of such nature and application that the State Fiscal

30 Officer shall be able to maintain adequate records in his books of 31 accounts of all fiscal operations of the state, and in no event 32 shall the regular audit of the transactions of such departments, 33 institutions and agencies by the State Department of Audit be 34 suspended.

35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2000.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7-7-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2AUTHORIZE THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO PROMULGATE REGULATIONS AND 3 PROCEDURES REGARDING THE POSTAUDITING OF CLAIMS AND THE ISSUANCE 4OF WARRANTS AND OTHER FORMS OF PAYMENTS FOR ALL STATE AGENCIES, 5 DEPARTMENTS AND INSTITUTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
