8 Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting 9 in lieu thereof the following:

- 11 SECTION 1. Section 43-6-151, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 12amended as follows:
- 13 43-6-151. Sections 43-6-151 through 43-6-155 shall be known 14as and may be cited as the "Mississippi Support Animal Act."
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 43-6-155, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 16 amended as follows:
- 43-6-155. (1) Any blind person, mobility impaired person or 18hearing impaired person who uses a dog or other animal 19specifically trained as a guide, leader, listener or for any other 20assistance necessary to assist such blind, mobility impaired or 21hearing impaired person in day-to-day activities shall be entitled 22to the full and equal accommodations, advantages, facilities and 23privileges of all public conveyances, hotels, lodging places, 24businesses open to the public for the sale of any goods or 25services and all places of public accommodation, amusement, or 26resort and other places to which the general public is invited, 27and may take the dog or other animal into \* \* \* conveyances and 28places, subject only to the conditions and limitations applicable 29to all persons not so accompanied, except that:
- 30 (a) The dog or other animal shall not occupy a seat in

- 31 any public conveyance.
- 32 (b) The dog <u>or other animal</u> shall be upon a leash <u>or</u>
  33 <u>otherwise sufficiently restrained in a manner appropriate for the</u>
  34 <u>animal</u> while using the facilities of a common carrier.
- 35 (2) Trainers of support dogs <u>and other support animals</u> shall 36have the same rights of accommodations, advantages, facilities and 37privileges with support <u>animals</u>-in-training as those provided to 38blind, mobility impaired <u>or</u> hearing impaired persons with support 39<u>animals</u> under this section.
- 40 (3) No person shall deprive a blind, mobility
  41 impaired, \* \* \* hearing impaired person, or a support animal
  42 trainer of any of the advantages, facilities or privileges
  43 provided in this section, nor charge such blind, mobility impaired
  44 or hearing impaired person or support animal trainer a fee or
  45 charge for the use of the animal.
- 46 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 47 and after July 1, 2000.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 43-6-151, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2TO CHANGE THE TITLE OF THE MISSISSIPPI SUPPORT DOG ACT TO THE 3MISSISSIPPI SUPPORT ANIMAL ACT; TO AMEND SECTION 43-6-155, 4MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW ALL ANIMALS SPECIFICALLY 5TRAINED TO ASSIST DISABLED PERSONS TO HAVE ACCESS TO PUBLIC 6FACILITIES WITH CERTAIN LIMITATIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
