- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37-9-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-9-13. Each school district shall have a superintendent of
- 9 schools, selected in the manner provided by law. No person shall
- 10 be eligible to the office of superintendent of schools unless such
- 11 person:

- 12 (a) Holds a valid administrator's license issued by the
- 13 State Department of Education and $\underline{\text{has}}$ not less than four (4) years
- 14 of classroom or administrative experience; or
- (b) Holds a valid Certified School Business
- 16 Administrator's certificate issued by the State Department of
- 17 Education and has not less than four (4) years of experience as a
- 18 school business administrator.
- 19 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 20 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 21 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 22 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 23 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 24 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 25 extended.
- 26 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2001, if it is effectuated on or before that
- 28 date under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended
