HOUSE BILL NO. 1331

L	AN ACT TO REQUIRE GAMING LICENSEES TO GIVE PREFERENCE TO
2	MISSISSIPPI RESIDENTS WHEN PURCHASING GOODS AND SERVICES FOR THEIR
3	GAMING ESTABLISHMENTS AND TO PURCHASE A CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF SUCH
4	GOODS AND SERVICES FROM MISSISSIPPI RESIDENTS; AND FOR RELATED
5	PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. In all contracts or purchases for the provision
- 8 of goods or services to a gaming licensee's licensed gaming
- 9 establishment and related facilities, the licensee shall give
- 10 preference and priority to Mississippi residents, laborers,
- 11 vendors and suppliers and shall purchase at least fifty percent
- 12 (50%) of such goods or services from Mississippi residents,
- 13 laborers, vendors and suppliers, except where not reasonably
- 14 possible to do so without added expense, substantial inconvenience
- 15 or sacrifice in operational efficiency.
- 16 Each gaming licensee shall report annually to the Mississippi
- 17 Gaming Commission, at a time determined by the commission,
- 18 regarding the licensee's compliance with the provisions of this
- 19 section.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2001.
