HOUSE BILL NO. 1618 (As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE
2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE
3 STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR FORESTERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
4 2002.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters
9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board
10 of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning
11 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 33,300.00.

12 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that no
13 funds appropriated in Section 1 shall be expended by the State
14 Board of Registration for Foresters until the board has allowed
15 Earl Glynn Stuckey a certification hearing.

16 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
17 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
18 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
19 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
20 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
21 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

22 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
23 and after July 1, 2001.
