15 of Prelaw Majors, advisor for prelaw students, organizer of the
16 study abroad program and initiator of the Honors Program; and

18 her selection as a Lamplighter and a recipient of a Fulbright
19 Seminars Abroad Fellowship, where she spent two months in
20 Pakistan; and

21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Grisham has been lovingly supported in all her
22 endeavors by her husband, Dr. Vaughn Grisham; and

23 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize
24 and commend outstanding educators such as Mrs. Grisham, who has
25 dedicated her career to teaching the young people of this state:
