1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MS.

7 Community Campus of the Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College

16 Diploma instructor, has been employed at the Mississippi Gulf  
17 Coast Community College for the past nine years; and

18 WHEREAS, Ms. Bragg received an associate's degree from  
19 Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College and a bachelor's degree  
20 and master's degree from the University of Southern Mississippi;

22 WHEREAS, throughout her career, Ms. Bragg has served as  
23 Workforce Specialist, Research Consultant, Elementary School  
24 Teacher and Chairperson and Secretary for the Adult Literacy  
25 Partners in Service; and

26           WHEREAS, it is the policy of this Legislature to recognize  
27 and commend outstanding teachers such as Ms. Bragg, who has  
28 dedicated her career to teaching the young people of this state:
