- 5 SECTION 1. Section 13-5-95, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 13-5-95. In selecting overnight accommodations for jurors,
- 8 the court shall provide separate housing for men and women jurors.
- 9 Male bailiffs shall accompany the male jurors, and female bailiffs
- 10 the female jurors. At least one (1) bailiff shall accompany each
- 11 group, and the court in its sound discretion shall require as many
- 12 bailiffs as are necessary. Either group may be housed in private
- 13 premises if necessary. <u>Each bailiff shall receive a per diem of</u>
