

REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3090: Appropriation; Personnel Bd.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6 Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board for the
7 support and maintenance of the State Personnel Board for the
8 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002....
9 \$ 4,961,595.00.

10 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
11 of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
12 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

13 expenditure:

30 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
31 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
32 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
33 Services" for Fiscal Year 2003 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2002
34 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions

35 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2003 budget by the
36 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
37 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
38 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
39 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
40 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
41 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
42 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2002 appropriation for "Personal
43 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
44 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
45 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
46 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2002 "Personal Services"
47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions
48 which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
49 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
50 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

51 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance
52 with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

53 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
54 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which
55 are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of
56 this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

57 SECTION 3. In addition to all other funds, the following
58 sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
59 appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit
60 of the State Personnel Board Training Fund account, for the
61 purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Personnel Board
62 Training Seminars for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, and
63 ending June 30, 2002..... \$ 577,600.00.

64 It is the intention of the Legislature that the State
65 Personnel Board Training Fund shall have the authority, should
66 additional funds become available, to escalate and expend those
67 funds in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
68 Department of Finance and Administration, in a manner consistent
69 with the escalation of federal funds.

70 The funds authorized under the provisions of this section
71 shall be held separate and apart from all other funds in the
72 State Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board.

73 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
74 of Section 3, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
75 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
76 expenditure:

5 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State
6 Personnel Board shall have the authority to escalate and expend funds
7 received from state agencies for reimbursement of costs associated with the
8 hiring of court reporters used in the Employee Appeals Process. Such
9 funds shall be received and expended under the rules and regulations of the
10 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the
11 escalation of federal funds.

12 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the
13 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the
14 proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the
15 State Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
16 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the
17 manner provided by law.

18 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after
19 July 1, 2001.
